### Stoning in Islam

According to Hadith Sahih

Volume 2, Book 23, Number 413:

Narrated 'Abdullah bin 'Umar :

The Jew brought to the Prophet a man and a woman from amongst them who have committed adultery (illegal sexual intercourse). He ordered both of them to be stoned (to death) near the place of offering the funeral prayers beside the mosque.\*

Narrated 'Aisha:

Sad bin Abi Waqqas and 'Abu bin Zama' were stoned over a boy. Sad said: "O Allah's Apostle! This boy is the son of a laborer working for this man, and he committed illegal sexual intercourse with his wife. The people told me that my son should be stoned to death; so, in lieu of that, I paid a ransom of one hundred sheep and a slave girl to save my son. Then I asked the learned scholars who said, "Your son has to be lashed one-hundred lashes and has to be exiled for one year." The Prophet said, "I am a judge between you according to Allah's Laws. The slave-girl and the sheep are to go back to you, your son is to receive a hundred lashes and be exiled for one year. You, Unais, go to the wife of this (man) and if she confesses her guilt, stone her to death." Then the Prophet said, "O Sada bint Zama! Screen yourself from this boy." So, Sada never saw him again.
